Dr. Tony Kuo received his Ph.D. in America Studies from Tamkang University, Taiwan in 2002. He has published “The American Think Tanks and Their Influence on the U.S. Cross-Straits Policy Making” and “Academic-Industrial Collaboration Case Study: Establishing Internationalized Environments” for academic research. Dr. Tony Kuo has been a Committee Member in Youth Development Administration, Ministry of Education (2008-2017) and CEO of Zypher Foundation (2015-2017).

He has been contributing to International higher education for decades. In 2011, he established the Office of International Affairs in Shih Chien University and served as the Dean. He has also been an advisor of Taiwan Study Center of George Washington University since 2002, a visiting scholar of Henry L. Stimson Center in Washington DC since 2010, and a visiting scholar of University of Texas at Austin since 2016. In 2019, he assumed several administrative positions at National Taipei University of Education as Chief Director of the Global Affairs Office, the Director of Learning and Instruction International Graduate Program, and the Associate Professor of Southeast Regional Studies Graduate Program.
